- Melissa Henderson, Fire Marshal and Building Inspector
  - Reported on meeting with Ann Coggins, Chris Lagerbloom, and Alice Wakefield re: input from MDAC for building/development compliance
  - Melissa is using references (i.e. "Georgia Accessibility Code for Buildings and Facilities" to develop a checklist for meeting codes re: accessibility
  - There is currently a "post" checklist for development, however need to develop a "pre" checklist. Discussed "pre-development package."
  - Presented draft of "Building Division Certification ADA Compliance" form. Discussion of signatures. Melissa to add Development Owner in addition to present signatures: Architect, Developer, and General Contractor.
  - Discussed concern that merchants can go back and change post certification, and then we have no recourse as there is only an inspection once a year and it really focuses on safety and fire issues.
  - Action Items: Melissa will develop a working checklist and present to MDAC, Marie to share her checklists with Melissa as resources.
- Transportation: Leah Vaughn and Faye Dimassimo, Consultants for Transportation Plan
  - Explanation and presentation on Transportation Plan, goals, and request for feedback on areas of concern re: accessibility.
  - Plan is currently in needs assessment phase.
  - MDAC IDed concerns with some including: Curb cuts at intersections, position and height of signals at intersections, transit.
  - Action Items: Specific examples of concerns were requested. MDAC to identify in Milton and respond.
- Marie Latta presented an update to the committee discussing ABCD, Resolution for Accessibility, Accessible Housing Ordinance, and Emergency Preparedness Plan.
