WHEREAS, The City of Milton, Georgia is a newly incorporated City in Fulton County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Jan Jones, State Representative District 46, sponsored House Bill 1470 to create the new City in January 2005; and

WHEREAS, On March 9, 2006, the Bill creating the new city of Milton passed in the House (127-21) and passed in the Senate (49-0); and

WHEREAS, At 2:00 PM on Wednesday March 28, 2006, Governor Sonny Perdue signed HB 1470 into law; and


WHEREAS, In an overwhelming show of support, on July 18, 2006, 86% of the voters approved the City of Milton referendum which granted self determination to its residents; and


WHEREAS, State Representative Jan Jones continues to work for the people of Georgia, for her district, and for the City of Milton;





District 1






