**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILTON, GEORGIA TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY
MANAGER TO FILE A NOTICE OF INTENT WITH THE GEORGIA
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION DIVISION IN ORDER TO BE COVERED UNDER
A NPDES PERMIT FOR DISCHARGES FROM A STORMWATER SYSTEM**

The Council of the City of Milton hereby resolves while in regular session on the 16th day of August, 2007 at 7 pm:

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2000 the Environmental Protection Agency promulgated rules establishing Phase II of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) storm water program; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations part 122.33 require an operator of a small municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) to apply for coverage under an NPDES permit for discharges from its storm sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milton's storm water system qualifies as a MS4 system; and

WHEREAS, it is required that a permit tee must file a Notice of Intent to be covered under the permit and be compliant with the Code of Federal Regulations; and


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILTON that the City Manager is hereby granted the authority to prepare and submit the Georgia Notice of Intent for the general NPDES permit No. GAG61000 for Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4).
