The purpose of the North Fulton Comprehensive Transportation Plan is to provide the foundation and framework for multimodal, multijurisdictional infrastructure, and policy recommendations across the distinctive and unique cities of Alpharetta, Johns Creek, Milton, Sandy Springs, Roswell and Mountain Park. The resulting document, TRIP (Transportation Resources Implementation Program), will guide the accomplishment of this effort. Input from the public and stakeholders will be sought throughout the project schedule.

A key outcome of the program is to identify and reconfirm community visions and priorities. Roadway, transit, bicycle, pedestrian, safety and operational improvements, demand management, freight movement, environmental, land use and market analysis are critical study components.
